Title: "Chief Minister's Medal" for Home Guards and Civil Defence Personnel

Introduction: The Chief Minister's Medal shall be conferred on the members of the Karnataka State Home Guards & Civil Defence Personnel. The following rules are made governing the award of medals.

1. These Rules shall be called as "The Karnataka Chief Minister's Medal Home Guards Rules 2007.
2. These Rules shall be applicable to all member's of Karnataka Home Guards.
3. The Medal shall be in three forms:
 - a. Gold Medal
 - b. Silver Medal
 - c. Bronze Medal

I. All the Medals shall be circular in shape and 1-1½ in diameter.

II. The obverse of the Medal shall have embossed on it the following words in Kannada with the Karnataka State Emblem in the Centre.

III. On the reverse it shall be inscribed with the words "Chief Minister's Medal" with the year in which it was awarded on the top.

For out standing performance (on the Gold Medal)

For exemplary service (on the silver Medal)

For good work (on the Bronze Medal)

4. The Medal shall have -

- i. In the Middle there shall be the Motif of Vidhans Soudha.
- ii. The Gold Medal shall be of Copper/Bronze of 30 Grams in weight with gold glit.
- iii. The Silver Medal shall be of Copper/Bronze of 30 Grams in weight with Silver glit.
- iv. The Bronze Medal shall be of Bronze of 30 Grams in weight.

5. The Medal shall carry cash awards.

- i. The Gold Medal shall carry a cash reward of Rs. 5000/- only along with the Medal.
- ii. The Silver Medal shall carry a cash award of Rs. 3000/- only along with the Medal.
- iii. The bronze Medal shall carry a cash award of Rs. 2000/- only along with the Medal.

6. The names of those to whom this Medal is awarded shall be published in the Karnataka Government Gazette of the next issue after presentation. A Register of such names shall be kept in the Home Department and in the office of the Director General of Police and Commandant General Home Guards, Bangalore.

7. The number of Medals to be awarded each year shall be decided by the DGP & Commandant General Home Guards keeping in view the number of Citations received. " But the number shall not exceed 30, to each in Gold, Silver and Bronze per annum.

8. The Medals shall be awarded for exceptional skill or conspicuous devotion to duty or extraordinary service in saving lives and properties or exceptional excellence in sports at the National level or State level or for any other act of conspicuous bravery and courage or other outstanding work not specified here. The Medals can also be awarded posthumously. The medals can be awarded to the voluntary staff of and above the rank of Home Guards to the rank District Commandant and the permanent instructional staff of and above the rank of Sainik to Deputy Commandant.

9. Every year the commandants of Home Guards of all districts shall be asked to send recommendations with full details of the turn out of the Home Guards officers and Home Guards to the office of the Director General of Police and Commandant General of Home Guards by the 31st July every year. On receipt of the recommendations in the office of the DGP and the Commandant General Home Guards, the Deputy Commandant General Home Guards and Deputy Director of Civil Defence will scrutinize the recommendations received from the Commandants and place it before the DGP & Commandant General Home Guards through the Inspector General of Police and Addl. Commandant General, Home Guards and Addl. Director of Civil Defence. The Director General of Police and Commandant General Home Guards may forward his final recommendation to the Secretary to Government Home Department before 10th of September every year.

10. The award shall be announced by the Government of Karnataka on the 15th October every year.
11. The investiture of the Medal shall be on the Home Guards Day, i.e., on 6th December every year at Bangalore.
12. A member of the Home Guards and Civil Defence is not rewarded more than once by the State Government for one and the same performance. However, in the course of his tenure, it is possible that an officer or a Home Guard displays his extraordinary ability, which may be worth recognition. In such cases, it may be necessary to award the medal, but there shall be a time gap of five years to award another medal. The lower medals should not be awarded to any recipient i.e., an officer who has once been awarded Gold Medal, should not be awarded either Silver Medal or Bronze Medal and Similarly, one who has been awarded Silver Medal should not be awarded Bronze Medal. There should be no objection for awarding medal on more than one occasion of the same or higher class.
13. No recommendation for the award of Medal shall be sent when an officer/official is of doubtful integrity or has been awarded a major punishment under the Karnataka Home Guards Act, 1962 and the Karnataka Home Guards Rules, 1963 or has at any time incurred any censure of a Court of Law. Certificate in the following form shall be furnished in respect of each recommendation by recommending authorities.

CERTIFICATE

Certified that the integrity of Shri.....
..... recommended for the award of Karnataka Chief Minister's Medal is above suspicion and that he was not concerned in any proceedings that were censured in a Court of Law. It is further certified that in respect of the conduct of the nominee underlying the present recommendation no judicial proceedings are pending.

14. The Medal shall not be worn by any Home Guards Officer.
15. It shall be competent for the Government of Karnataka to cancel the award of the Medal to any person and thereafter his name in the register shall be removed.
16. Every person to whom the said medal is awarded shall, before receiving the same, enter into an agreement to return the medal if his name is removed from the register. The agreement should be in the following proforma :-

AGREEMENT

I to whom the Karnataka Chief Minister's Medal is awarded declare that I have read over and understood the conditions attached to the Medal. I hereby undertake to return the Medal if at any time my name is removed from the register of awardees, when called upon to do so in accordance with the provision of the Chief Minister's Medal Rules.
